Thank you for your interest in making a gift of securities to Washington National Cathedral. Washington National Cathedral is a division of the Protestant Episcopal Cathedral Foundation (PECF), the single legal entity.

Before transferring your gift please alert giftofstock@cathedral.org, mkochan@cathedral.org and cynthia_pierce@ml.com (receiving broker) that a gift is being transferred, as donated stock that arrives in our account without identification may delay the issuance of a tax-deductible receipt. You may also sign your gift letter with your legal signature/s, and communicate your intention to Washington National Cathedral's Development Office by mailing or faxing copies of the letter to Marilyn Kochan (see below.)

Important: In your email alert, please include:

1. The donor's name
2. The name, ticker symbol, and number of shares of the stock being donated
3. The allocation of the gift i.e. Cathedral Fund (which supports the operating budget in the year received,) or other program support, such as music, worship, or preservation
4. Please also indicate if the gift is to be allocated amongst other PECF divisions
5. The mailing address of the donor for issuance of tax receipt
