HOW TO ASSEMBLE THANKSGIVING BASKETS

This year, the Cathedral's Thanksgiving baskets will adapt to the reality of the scarce supply and high costs of turkeys. The baskets will contain the fixings for a Thanksgiving meal for four people, as well as a grocery gift card so families may purchase their own protein.

To meet the goal of at least 700 Thanksgiving food baskets, we invite the Cathedral and Close family to assemble one or more sturdy shopping bags <u>at home</u> filled with all of the following ingredients:

- 2 Cut Green Beans, 14.5 oz cans or equivalent
- 2 Whole Kernel Corn, 15.25 oz cans or equivalent
- 2 Cranberry Sauce (Whole or Jellied), 14 oz cans or equivalent
- 1 Sweet Potatoes/Candied Yams, 40 oz can or equivalent
- 2 Instant Mashed Potatoes, 13.7 boxes or equivalent
- 2 Stuffing Mix for Turkey, 6 oz boxes or equivalent
- 2 Turkey Gravy, 10.5 oz cans or equivalent
- 2 Macaroni & Cheese, 7.25 oz boxes or equivalent
- 1 Cake Mix, 15.25 oz box or equivalent
- 1 Icing, 16 oz can or equivalent

Assembled food baskets can be delivered to the Cathedral Library between **8 a.m. and 3 p.m.** on any of the following days:

Friday, November 11 Saturday, November 12 Sunday, November 13 Thursday, November 17 Friday, November 18 Saturday, November 19 Sunday, November 20

All food baskets will be delivered to our community partners by November 21.
