Shopping List

Please assemble one or more sturdy grocery/shopping bags **at home** filled with the **complete** list of ingredients:

- **2 Cut Green Beans**, 14.5 oz cans or equivalent
- **2 Whole Kernel Corn**, 15.25 oz cans or equivalent
- **2 Cranberry Sauce (Whole or Jellied)**, 14 oz cans or equivalent
- **1 Sweet Potatoes/Candied Yams**, 40 oz can or equivalent
- **2 Instant Mashed Potatoes**, 13.7 boxes or equivalent
- **2 Stuffing Mix for Turkey**, 6 oz boxes or equivalent
- **2 Turkey Gravy**, 10.5 oz cans or equivalent
- **2 Macaroni & Cheese**, 7.25 oz boxes or equivalent
- **1 Cake Mix**, 15.25 oz box or equivalent
- **1 Icing**, 16 oz can or equivalent
